Folio: The Seattle Athenaeum is a membership-supported library that offers readers access to thousands of books for browsing and borrowing. Located on the third floor of the Economy Market building, the library provides members with a quiet space to peruse the shelves, read in comfortable chairs, or work on writing projects.

In addition to access to a previously private book collection, Folio offers programs to the public such as book discussion groups, author readings, and meeting spaces.



Leading American cities boast these membership libraries, continuing a tradition created by Benjamin Franklin in Philadelphia in 1731. Folio's founder, David Brewster, described the library as "a quiet perch in the heart of the Market; a place that celebrates physical books, great writing, and making interesting new friends." This summer, the PDA has curated a mix of farmer, producer and crafter focused events as well as weekly live entertainment. Below is a breakdown of each event and when and where they will be on the MarketFront.

- **Culinary Pop-ups on the MarketFront Plaza:** Highlighting food producers who sell at Pike Place Farmers Markets around downtown Seattle. These will occur Friday - Sunday, ending October 28.

- **"Downtown Summer Sounds" concerts on the MarketFront Lower Level Promenade:** Hosting the Downtown Seattle's Association's afternoon concerts on Wednesdays, Market-goers can enjoy free outdoor concerts at the bottom of the grand staircase. These will occur every Wednesday starting July 11 and ending August 29.
