Restoration of the Public Market Clock & Sign

May 9 – June 14

Hello Market Community,

The Public Market Clock & Sign is being restored by a PDA Contractor starting on May 9 and finishing on June 14. As the Public Market Clock & Sign is a pinnacle attraction here at Pike Place Market, the PDA and PDA Contractor will work to complete this work as quickly and efficiently as possible. While we understand the impact this will have for the time being, it is necessary to maintain and restore Pike Place Market attractions for the vitality of the Market.

While work is being completed, the Public Market Clock & Sign will not be visible to the public. Scaffolding will be erected in front of the sign and mesh will wrap the exterior of the scaffolding while work is being performed. Work includes scaffold, partial neon removal, sanding and painting.

The schedule for work is as follows, the items in red are impacts on our community. Please read.



May 9: Scaffolding will be moved up to the sign from Pike Place (*see map*). Starting at 5am, the space under the clock and sign will be blocked off for the crew to load scaffolding onto the roof. Scaffolding load is estimated to take 8 hours. A Noise Variance permit has been approved by SDOT for a start time of 5am to 4pm. The contractors will try to be as quiet as possible while this work is being performed.

May 10 – 12: Scaffolding erected on the Roof

May 13: Neon Removal from Clock 7am - 5pm

May 13 – June 8: Restoration Work 7am - 5pm

June 9 – 14: Scaffolding Removal (*see map*)
The space under the clock and sign will be blocked off for the crew to unload scaffolding from the roof. The tentative scaffold unloading day will be June 13th.
